



Traditional B.S.: Spring 2018

Admission Requirements: Second-degree candidates

Applicants must present the following minimum requirements to be eligible to apply for admission:

1. Have an earned bachelor's degree in a field other than nursing from a regionally-accredited college or university. This can be outstanding at the time of application but must be completed prior to the start of the program.
2. Be eligible for readmission to or be in good standing at the last college attended.
3. Have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5 on a scale of 4.0 on all college coursework.
4. Complete the following prerequisites prior to enrollment.

* Course work may not be more than 10 years old at the time of application.
