The Unseen Wellbeing Dilemma: Nurse Loneliness

The overarching goal of this program of research is to promote a stable, healthy nursing workforce, whereby the central hypothesis is that loneliness negatively impacts wellbeing and hinders a stable, healthy workforce. The three currently active studies explore this phenomenon across two subspecialties of nurses while also building a more robust, timely data set to further understand the experience of nurse loneliness and begin to identify areas for intervention development.

Perinatal Cannabis Use and Breastfeeding: A Feasibility Study.

Understanding Maternal Attitudes about Tobacco and THC Employing Research

The purpose of this study is to determine feasibility of collecting data from women post-delivery at VCU. The project, U MATTeR, collects anonymous survey data about cannabis and other substance use as well as urine and breast milk samples to assay for cannabinoids. Preliminary analyses found 15% of study participants reported cannabis use during pregnancy. Study findings will be used to support future grant proposals focused on perinatal cannabis use (\$50,000).
